**Saturday: 5 PM – 10 PM**

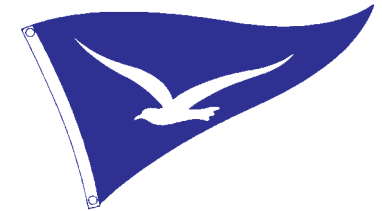
